

2025Color Trends

Greener blues, yellower greens, redder browns, warmer neutrals & blush as a versatile core all play a part in 2025's key color trends.



Blue



Blues are still getting greener & dustier and with all the browns taking over gray, we are seeing that 90s teal + brown color story making a comeback.

Brown



I think we may be seeing more redbrowns and chocolates that hedge either port or eggplant.



Green shades are shifting more yellow to mossier olive-tones, army & deep forest floor colors. Even some retro mint greens are gaining especially in multi palettes.



As gray gave way to all white over the past few seasons, we're now seeing more warm neutrals, creamier colors, wood-tone browns and warm metallics come in as our core neutrals.

Neutrals

Blush



Blush is still very popular and has really become a new "core" neutral that combines with just about every other trending color. I don't think this color will go away anytime soon. It's solidifying itself as less trendy and more core.

Trending Textures

get the look: R-Hamlet **R-Cedric** R-Drive

Bouclé is peaking as the main texture trend, especially white bouclé. Designers are shifting to more interesting multi-color textures that combine different yarn types. I think bouclé is still a core yarn texture, we're not going to see it go away totally, we're just going to see it used more in combination with different kinds of yarn & especially infused with more color.

As we shift from dryer-feeling bouclé, there's going to be more of a trend towards plush, luxurious textures like chenilles and velvets coming back in.






2025 Trending Aesthetic: Modern Tradition

Modern tradition is still a dominant design aesthetic, with the cottage/English country house look at the core. Designers are looking to infuse the home with nostalgic personal style with a feminine touch. Block prints, plaids and floral tapestries or prints that look like old world tapestries are super popular.

I see this whole trend continuing and getting a fresh French country take in 2025 with more "real" tapestry jacquards, toile, gingham plaid & perhaps a chicken novelty!

Playful Geometric


Playful geometrics and vibrant 70sinspired colors create a West Coast contemporary vibe with a nostalgic, laid-back sophistication.
